To its north, south and South-east, Tripura has an international boundary with Bangladesh while to its east it shares a common boundary with two Indian states of Assam and Mizoram. This panoramic tiny state is inhabited by 19 ethnic tribes, Bengali and Manipuri etc. communities. Tripura is blessed with its scenic beauties, historic palaces, rock-cut carvings, stone sculptures, museums, breath-taking verdant hills, Buddhist and Hindu holy places, and bio-diversity treasure troves of wildlife sanctuaries. The pollution free, eco friendly environment, pleasant climate, and its cross-cultural ethnic diversity, its rich tradition of handicrafts and handloom are tempting enough to draw the attention of the tourist to visit the destination again and again.

1.State Museum - Ujjayanta Palace, Agartala

The gleaming white Ujjayanta Palace located in the capital city of Agartala evokes the age of Tripura Maharajas. It is a unique experience to witness living history and royal splendor within the walls of Ujjayanta Palace. Constructed a little over a hundred years ago in 1901 A.D., this Indo-Saracenic building is set in large Mughal-style gardens on a lakefront. The Royal House which stands in the capital city Agartala covering one sq. Km. Area was built by Maharaja Radha Kishore Manikya and houses the State Museum at present.

2. Neermahal, Melaghar

Melaghar is important Tourist spot in Tripura which is famous for Neermahal (water Palace) located picturesquely in the midst of the scenic Rudrasagar Lake. Built in 1930 as the summer residence of Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya, the palace was inspired by Mughal and Hindu architectural styles. The spectacular edifice still reflects the wave of its past glory and castes its spell on the mind of the visiting tourists. It is the only water palace in North East India. The lake covers an area of about 5.3 sq. k.m. and is home to a variety of Migratory birds and aquatic plants. The tracts of green fields edging the Rudrasagar lake come alive during the annual arrival of the migratory birds.



4. Tripurasundari Temple, Udaipur

The 11th century old Tripura style of temple architecture is located on the hilltop situated at Udaipur (the former capital of Manikya dynasty Kings). Tripurasundari temple occupies a place of distinction among all the Hindu religious shrines as it earns special veneration on account of being one of the 51 Peethas of Hindu Centre of worship.

5. Chaturdash Devata Temple, Old Agartala

Chaturdash Devata Temple is located at Khayerpur, Old Agartala. Before 1770 A.D. the images of fourteen Gods were in Udaipur in two temples beside Tripureshwar Bhairab Temple. Maharaja Krishna Manikya, being defeated by Shamser Gazi, shifted his capital from Udaipur to Old Agartala and the images of Fourteen Gods were also taken to the new capital and installed in a new temple. On the occation of the speacial Puja of the Fourteen Gods known as 'Kharchi Puja', a grand fair is held in and around the old palace.

6. Kasba Kali Temple, Kamalasagar

The venerated Shakti Shrine was built on a hill-top by Maharaja Dhanya Manikya in the late 15th century. It is situated just beside the Bangladesh border. Maharaja Dhanya Manikya (1940-1520) dug a large water body in front of the temple and named it Kamalasagar following the name of his wife Kamaladevi. Over the years the Durga temple of Kalyan Manikya turned into a Kali temple of Kasba.



Dumboor Lake is a charming water body and the look of the lake is like tabor shaped small drum, 'Dumboor' of Lard Shiva from which the name 'Dumboor' originates. The area of the lake is 41 sq.km. and there are 48 islets inside the lake. The surrounding hills and the islets and enchantingly emerald green and present a captivating scenic spectacle. Winter attracts hundreds of migratory birds of wild variety attributing the lake the status of healthy wetland habitat much to the delight of ornithologists and tourists.

13. Sepahijala Wildlife Sanctuary (Clouded Leopard National park), Bishalgarh

Sepahijala Wild Life Sanctuary is truly the biodiversity heaven of Tripura with an area of 18.54 sq.km. The Sanctuary has not less than 456 plant species. Many kinds of bamboo and a variety of grasses and medicinal plants also grow in the sanctuary. It is here that one can find nearly 4500 cubic meters per hectare of timber biomass. The moist, deciduous forest is the habitat of different species of primates like rhesus macaque, pigtailed macaque, capped langur, spectacled monkey, slow loris, and several other wild animals such as the leopard, clouded leopard, jungle fowl, civets, barking deer, the wild pig and elephants.

At the height of Bangladesh crisis in 1971 Kalapania had played host to thousands of refugees from that country and a crematorium had come up on the land owned by a magnanimous tribal Tripura. The refugees had duly left and obscure Kalapania returned to languish in days of desolation, obscure even to most of the people in Sabroom subdivision.

19. Heritage Park

The Heritage Park, spread over twelve acre of land, is located at the centre of the city, on the northern side of Raj Bhawan on the Agartala-GBP Hospital road. This park was inaugurated on the 30th November 2012 by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Tripura. Entrance to the park has an imposing gate constructed with depicting the rich tribal, nontribal mixed cultural heritage of Tripura, both tribal and non-tribal. The park has three parts, viz. (i) mini-Tripura located in about three acre of land at the entrance, (ii) central area being raised as natural forest, and (iii) a plain table land with medicinal plants, herbs and shrubs. There is a walking track of 1.1 kilometer running along the periphery of the park.



20. Bharat -Bangla Maitree Uddyan, Chottakhola

Chottakhola, 140 km from Agartala and functioned as one of the War from Camps in Tripura in 1971. Chottakholla, a border town was one of the base camp of Mukti Judhas (Bangladesh Freedom Fighters) from where they launched Gorilla war fare against Pakistani Troops in Noakhali, Feni and parts of Comilla Districts of Bangladesh. Tripura Government to memorate the 40th Year of Bangladesh Independence has also built an Eco Park at Chottakholla including a statue of Bangabandhu, the architect of Bangladesh's independence Shekh Mujibar Rahman. Located near the Indo-Bangladesh boarder the Bharat-Bangladesh Maitree Udyan Park (India-Bangladesh Friendship Park) is a tribute to Indian soldiers and Bangladeshi Freedom Fighters who sacrifice their life's during the liberation war.

21. Surmacherra Waterfalls, Kamalpur

The place has green and scotching natural beauty. Panoramic view of Kamalpur valley from a hilltop adjoining Bangladesh Border makes a pleasant site. The village, consisting of Upper and Lower Sanaiya Reang Para is the habitat of Reang tribes, which is one of the prominent tribes of Tripura. The centre of attraction is a waterfall located in a gorge providing a unique place as a tourist attraction. The convergence of natural beauty, ethnic tribal life, cultural and cuisine, bamboo handicrafts etc has made Saniya Reang Para an ideal place for the development of Rural Tourism. The natural wilderness with panoramic view tops and perennial fast flowing springs make the area an ideal location for rural tourism centre.







26. Unakoti, Kailasahar

Unakoti means one less than a crore. Unakoti is an important site of archeological wonder. It is a shaiva pilgrimage attraction and dates back to 7th – 9th centuries A.D. The site consists of several huge vertical rock-cut carvings on a hill side. The Unokoti rock-cut carving has the distinction of being the largest bas-relief sculpture in India.



27. Buddhist Stupa, Boxanagar

Recently after denudation of a natural forest area, ruins of a brick-built building emerged in the northwestern part of Sonamura Sub-Division on the edge of the border with Bangladesh. The local people initially attributed the remains to an ancient temple of Manasa — the goddess of Snake. Attention of the Archaeological Survey of India was drawn and they took over the site. There an idol of Lord Buddha was discovered and it was confirmed that it had been a Buddha Temple. More excavation of the site will unearth the hidden story.

Pilak is a place of attraction for its archeological remains of 8th – 9th centuries. The place is a treasure house of Buddhist and Hindu sculptures. Some huge stone images of Avlokiteswar of 9th century A.D. and Narasimha image of 12th century A.D. were found here. Two bronze statues of Buddhas were discovered in Rishyamukh near Pilak, the treasure-trove of archaeological riches has close association with Moynamoti and Paharpur in Bangladesh.



29. Gunabati Group of Temples, Udaipur

Gunabati group of temples reveals that it was built in the name of Her highness Maharani Gunabati (wife of Maharaja Govinda Manikya), in 1668 A.D. the two other temples also bear contemporary look but their actual history is still to be unveiled. Architecture of these temples resembles other contemporary temples of Tripura except that the top most parts are without stupa. Core — Chambers are marked by the presence of pitcher circular core chamber and its vestibule which was large with stupa like crown is beautifully crafted like lotus.



CULTURAL TOURISM OF TRIPURA

A happy feature of the people of Tripura is their love for music and dance. For instance, the Garia is a dance for the prosperity of the people while the Cheraw relates to the confinement of the lusai women. The Garia and Cheraw dances are not the only ones that the people of Tripura have part of their culture. Some of the others include: Hai-Hak: Dance of the Malsom community, Wangle: dance of the Garo community, Sangraika, Chimithang, Padisha and Abhangma: dances of the Mog community, Garia: dances of Koloi, Jamatia and Tripuri communities. Gajan, Dhamail, Sari and Rabindra: dances of benbali community, Basanta Rash and Pung Cholom: dances of the Manipuri community, Garia, Jhum, Maimita, Masak Sumani and Lebang Boomani: dances of the Tripuri community, Hozagiri: dance of the Reang community, Biju: dance of the Chakma community.

Each community has devised its own musical instruments. Some of the important musical instruments are the Kham (Drum), the bamboo Flute, Saringa, Do-tara and the Sarinda. Tripura has had a long and wonderful friendship with the Nobel laureate Rabindranath Tagore and this had added to the richness and quality of Tripura's culture. The state of Tripura is also very proud of two other musicians — Sachin Dev Barman and Rahul Dev Burman, both very influential figures in Indian popular culture.


